Sub: 6th All India DAD Chess Tournament to be organized by CDA, Chennai from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> August 2016 – regarding.

It has been intimated by the CDA, Chennai that the 6<sup>th</sup> All India DAD Chess Tournament at CHENNAI from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2016. The event will be held under the aegis of Defence Accounts Sports Control Board (DASCB).

The details of the tournament are indicated in the Annexure enclosed to this letter.

Entries to the Tournament will be as under:

- All sports quota (chess) players are allowed direct entry in the Tournament.
- In addition to the above, every organization may send one male participant and one female participant.
- All IFA Offices will be considered as part of the proforma Controller to whom they are attached. They will therefore take part in the internal matches conducted by the respective CsDA organization for qualification.
- There will be no direct entry for the winner/runner up of the last edition. They will also come through the normal selection process (unless they are sports quota (chess) players in which case they are allowed direct entry).

The secretary, DARC, Main office has been directed by the CDA to hold internal matches among the officers/staff under this organization in consultation with the DARC Secretaries of both the PAOs and the AAO(Army), Vizag by <u>26.07.2016</u> and to intimate the names of the selected players by the same date.

All the sub-office in-charges are requested to notify the content and grant necessary permission to the DARC Secretaries and the probable players for participating in the selection trials.
