As you are aware, the Government of India launched Har Ghar Tiranga (HGT) campaign in 2022 under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. The objective of this campaign has been to encourage citizens to hoist the national flag at their homes and build a personal and emotional connection with the Tiranga. Over the years, the campaign has become a successful Janbhagidari movement of national identity, patriotism, and pride.

- The HGT campaign was successfully implemented during the years 2022, 2023, and 2024, with the Tiranga being prominently hoisted across homes, offices, institutions, and public spaces nationwide on 15th August. Activities such as Selfie with Tiranga, Prabhat-pheris. Tiranga Rallies (including bike and cycle rallies), Tiranga exhibitions, along with other grassroots-level Janbhagidari initiatives, have made the Independence Day celebration with full of patriotism. participative and widely celebrated occasion across the country. The campaign also served as a special occasion for the public to pay heartfelt tribute to the freedom fighters and soldiers who laid down their lives in the service of the nation and in honour of the Tiranga.
- In continuation of this spirit, Government of India has decided to celebrate Har Ghar Tiranga 2025 across the country from 2nd to 15th August 2025, in three phases, as approved by the National Implementation Committee (NIC) on 24/07/2025. The phases are given as under:
 - Phase 1 will start from 2nd August and go on till 8th August 2025.
 - Phase 2 will start from 9th August and go on till 12th August 2025.
 - Phase 3 will start from 13th August and go on till 15th August 2025.
- Further, in accordance with the directions of the National Implementation Committee (NIC), the Ministry of Defence is requested to implement the activities towards HGT 2025 as highlighted in Annexure 1.
- In the above context, it is requested to kindly nominate a Nodal Officer from your Department to coordinate with the Ministry of Culture for effective implementation of the HGT 2025 campaign.

Annexure 1

HGT 2025 activities as directed by National Implementation Committee Ministry of Defence

1. Activity1: Facilitating the delivery of Tiranga Rakhi:

Tiranga Rakhi Making Competition or Workshop is an activity under HGT 2025in accordance with the directions of the National Implementation Committee. This will be organized by:

- Ministry of Women and Child Development(WCD) will organize workshop across various Childcare Centers and Anganwadi Centers in India.
- Ministry of Education (through Department of School Education and Literacy; and Department of Higher Education) will organize workshop across Schools, colleges, etc.)
- Government of States/UTs will organize competition and workshops.
- Department of Posts will coordinate with the above-mentioned stakeholders to collect and facilitate the delivery of these rakhis to jawans, soldiers and defence personnel.

Ministry of Defence is requested to coordinate with the Department of Posts to facilitate the delivery of Tiranga rakhis to various units of jawans, soldiers and defence personnel across the country under the purview of Ministry of Defence.

- 2. Activity 2: Facilitating the delivery of Tiranga Letters
 - Letter writing to Jawans, soldiers and defencepersonnel celebrating spirit of Tirangas and thanking the jawans, soldiers and armed forces for their service is an activity under HGT 2025 in accordance with the directions of the National Implementation Committee. This will be organized by:
 - Ministry of Education (through Department of School Education and Literacy across all schools in India).
 - Dept. of Posts to coordinate with the Ministry of Education to collect and deliver the letters from across the country.

Ministry of Defence is requested to coordinate with the Department of Posts to facilitate the delivery of Tiranga rakhis letters to various units of jawans, soldiers and defence personnel across the country under the purview of Ministry of Defence.

 Organize bike rallies/ cycle rallies/ Tiranga runs/ Tiranga yatraas across India during Phase 2 which will start from 9th August and go on till 12th August 2025.
